The following actions will be REQUIRED to attend as a voting member:

1. Each brother must be preregistered. NO late registrations will be allowed, All registrations must be mailed to PDC L. Dean Lamphere, Jr., Dept. Credentials Committee, 1062 Four Seasons Blvd, Aurora, IL 60504 by May 25, 2020.
2. Registration fees shall be waived. If you have already submitted a registration, with payment, a refund will be sent to you, unless you contact PDC Lamphere requesting your registration fee be donated to the Department.
3. Credential Cards are still needed, and must be delivered to the Credentials Committee prior to the day of the meeting. A fill-in PDF Credentials form will be available to be filled out by the Camp Secretary and submitted to the Department. Follow ALL instructions on the 136th Department Encampment page, for the Credentials Form.
4. We will be selecting platform which affords either video or voice only options. Instructions will be available at www.suvcwmi.org/DEindex-136.php in the near future.
5. The Encampment packet will be posted to the 136th Department Encampment page for download.
6. A list of Candidates is available on the 136th Department Encampment page for review.
7. Brothers are encouraged to have a Ceremonials and Rituals book on hand for reference.
8. Brothers, if you are up for a position, either by election or appointment, please have a Holy Bible on hand for being sworn in.
